CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

J. D. BOWMAN

Blattman Certificate 12-20-07

of Lexington, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Willow Creek, a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 75; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1903

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

11 acres in S.W. 1/4, 22 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, 2 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, 10 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 1, T. 2 S. R. 25 E. W. M., being a total of 45 acres.

Note: This is a Correction Certificate issued in lieu of a title to the land where in land description was not given.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
