that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

11 acres in $SL_1^1 \mathbb{R}^1_2$, 22 acres in $NL_1^2 \mathbb{R}^1_2$, 2 acres in $NL_2^2 \mathbb{R}^1_2$, 10 ecres in $SL_2^2 \mathbb{R}^1_2$, Section 1, 3. 2 S. 2. 25 E. V. M., being a total of 45 acres.
