CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. L. BABCOCK

of Kerby, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Sucker Creek
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 252; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893 for 37 acres; 1872 for 25 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per
second for 37 acres and 0.5 cubic foot per second for 25 acres; that the use of
water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1 to October
31 of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Cancelled - up to Dec. 1st, 1927 P. 3, 337

4 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 10 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, ^{20.94 ac} 26 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 2 acres
in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Township 39 South of Range 7 West, W. M.; and 20
acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, Township 39 South of Range 8 West of the Willa-
mette Meridian, being a total of 62 acres.

(NOTE: This right is supplemented by seepage and waste water from Gravelly Slough
under date of 1903.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
