CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

has a right to the use of

the waters of

Sucker Creek

for the purpose of Irrigation & domestic for Tract No. 1; Irrigation for Tract No. 2;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume S 1 & 5, at page S 252 & 7Rt the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1895 for Tract No. 1; 1908 for Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 1; 0.08 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 2; that the use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1st to October 31st of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1: 4 acres in the SELNEL, Section 23; 8 acres in the SWAWL, Section 24, T. 39 S. R. 7 W. W. M., being a total of 12 acres.

(NOTE: This right is supplemented by water from Little Grayback Creek under date of 1907, and from Baldwin Gulch under date of 1894.)

Tract No. 2: 3.4 acres in the SEANEL, Section 23; 2.8 acres in the SWANWA, Section 24, T. 39 S. R. 7 W. W. H., being a total of 6.2 acres.

(NOTE: This right is supplemented by water from Little Grayback Creek under date of 1907.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
