## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

has a right to the use of

the waters of

Sucker Creek

for the purpose of

Irrigation, domestic and stock;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephino County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1 . at page 252 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1857

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.02 cubic feet per second, and that the use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1st to October 31st of each year;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

21 acres in the SW1SE1, 20 acres in the SE1SE1, Section 32, 10 acres in the SW1SW1, Section 33, T. 39 S. R. 7 V. W. M., being parts of D.L.C. No. 38 and D.L.C. No. 39; and 20 acres in the NW1NW1, Section 4, 20 acres in the HE2ND1, Section 5, T. 40 S. R. 7 W. W. M., being parts of D.L.C. No. 40 and D.L.C. No. 41, being a total of 91 acres.

(NOTE: This right is supplemented by seepage and waste waters from Mulvaney Gulch and waste waters from Holland Ditch, under date of 1857.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
