CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That A. J. FULK

of Kerby, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Sucker Creek
for the purpose of Irrigation, domestic and stock;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volumes 1 & 3, at pages 252 & 396 that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1857;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.04 cubic feet per
second, and that the use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to
the season April 1st to October 31st of each year;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

4 acres in the SW¹/₄NE¹/₄, 37 acres in the NW¹/₄SE¹/₄, 5 acres in the SW¹/₄NE¹/₄, 26 acres
in the NE¹/₄NW¹/₄ and 30 acres in the NE¹/₄SW¹/₄ of Section 35, T. 39 S. R. 9 W. W. M.,
being a total of 102 acres.

this 14th day of April 1926

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
