CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That J. E. LEWIS

of Holland, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Sucker Creek
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1 & 5, at pages 255 & 298; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1872 for Tract #1; 1908 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.72 cubic foot per
second for 36 acres and 0.2 cubic foot per second for 10 acres of Tract #1; 0.12
cubic foot per second for Tract #2; and that the use for irrigation purposes shall
be confined to the season April 1st to October 31st of each year;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1: 16 acres in NE¹/₄NE¹/₄, 20 acres in SE¹/₄NE¹/₄ and 10 acres in the NW¹/₄NE¹/₄ of
Section 32, T. 39 S. R. 7 W. W. M., being a total of 46 acres.

Tract #2: 1.45 acres in the NE¹/₄NE¹/₄ and 8.50 acres in the SE¹/₄NE¹/₄ of Section 32,
T. 39 S. R. 7 W. W. M., being a total of 9.95 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
