CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That F. v. SAWYER

of Kerby , State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Suckor Creek

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1 & 5 , at page 253 2398: that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1862 for 0.56 sec. ft. of water for 28 acres of Tract #1 and 1899 for 0.5 sec. ft. of water for 25 acres of Tract #1; 1908 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.56 cubic foot per second for 28 acres and 0.5 cubic foot per second for 25 acres of Tract #1; 0.42 cubic foot per second for Tract #2; and that the use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1 to October 31; of each year;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1: 20 acres in the NELSW., 2 acres in the NW.SW., 4 acres in the SW2SW., 27 acres in the SESSW., Section 25, T. 39 S. R. 8 W. W. M., being a total of 53 acres.

Tract #2: 2.3 acres in the NVLSVL, 15.4 acres in the SVLSVL, Section 25, 9.3 acres in the NVLNVL of Section 36, T. 39 S. R. 8 V. V. M., being a total of 33.6 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
