CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That H. G. SISKRON

of Holland, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Yager Gulch
 for the purpose of Mining and power;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 255; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1903

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2 cubic feet per sec-
 ond, and that the use of water for mining purposes shall be confined to the season
 October 1 to July 1;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

January mining and milling claims, situated in
 about the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, T. 40 S. R. 7 W. M.
 The right for the power purposes is limited to
 the development of five (5) theoretical horsepower;

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
