CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ESTATE OF ALEX WHITE

of Kerby, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Sucker Creek
 for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volumes 1 & 5, at pages 254 & 299; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1858 for Tract #1; 1903 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.4 cubic feet per
 second for Tract #1; 0.37 cubic foot per second for Tract #2; and that the use
 of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1st to
 October 31st of each year;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1: 12 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, T. 39 S. R. 8 W. W. M.; 30 acres
 in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 25 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 3 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of
 Section 30, T. 39 S. R. 7 W. W. M., being a total of 70 acres.

Tract #2: 3 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 10 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 11.7 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$,
 Section 30, T. 39 S. R. 7 W. W. M., and 5 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section
 25, T. 39 S. R. 8 W. W. M., being a total of 29.7 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
