and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1 & 5 , at page 254 &399 : that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1889 for Tract #1; 1906 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.51 cubic feet per second for Tract #1; 0.66 cubic foot per second for Tract #2; and that the use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1 to October 31 of each year;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1: 19.5 acros in the NWAWA, 5 acros in the SWAWA, Section 27, 34 acros in the NWAWA, 7 acros in the SEAR, Section 28, T. 59 S. R. 7 W. W. M., being a total of 65% acros.

Tract #2: 8.1 acres in the NWANWA, 14 acres in the SEANWA, Section 27, 31 acres in the SEANWA, Section 28, T. 59 S. R. 7 W. W. H., being a total of 55.1 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
