## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GOSCHIE FARMS, INC. 7365 MERIDIAN ROAD NE SILVERTON, OREGON 97381

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the ZOLLNER CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 115.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11322. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 15, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.87 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 6, T 6 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 40 FEET NORTH AND 1955 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 40.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4 36.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 38.7 ACRES
SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

The water user shall report a March static water level in the well to the Groundwater/Hydrology Section of the Water Resources Department by April 15 of each year. All water level measurements shall be made by a qualified individual. Qualified individuals are Certified Water Rights Examiners, Registered Geologists, Registered Professional Engineers, Licensed Land Surveyors, Licensed Water Well Constructors, Licensed Pump Installers or the water user.

Use of water from the well shall not be allowed if the well displays an (A) average water level decline of 3 or more feet per year for 5 consecutive years, or (B) a water level decline if 15 or more feet in fewer than 5 consecutive years, or (C) a water level decline of 25 or more feet, or (D) a hydraulic interference decline of 25 or more feet in any neighboring well with senior priority which provides water for an authorized use.

The Water Resources Department has determined that the initial water level in the well are those of the initial March report. That is the level from which the cited declines in (A), (B) and (C) above will be referenced.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. When required by the department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior SURFACE OR GROUNDWATER rights of others.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
