CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, tributaries of COQUILLE RIVER, for IRRIGATING 0.5 ACRE AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This right was perfected under Permit 51058. The date of priority is APRIL 27, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.0045 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.002 CFS FROM STREAM FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.0025 CFS FROM RIVER FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

STREAM: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 7, T 27 S, 11 W, W.M.; 1299 FEET SOUTH AND 621 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17.

NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 7, T 27 S, R 11 W, W.M.; 1061' SOUTH AND 611' WEST OF THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 DOMESTIC
NE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.5 ACRE
 SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
