CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RUTH M. SAWYERS 27105 HIGHWAY 62 TRAIL, OR 97541

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of THE PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATING 5.16 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1894.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion under the subject right. IT IS ALSO ORDERED THAT DEMAND FOR WATER UNDER THIS RIGHT SHALL BE LIMITED TO REGULATION OF RIGHTS ON ELK CREEK.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 36, T 33 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 221 FEET SOUTH AND 264 FEET WEST FROM THE NE 1/16 CORNER OF SECTION 36.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.35 ACRE
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 1.81 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 3.00 ACRES
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices;

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water;

the original point of diversion may require a measuring device;

the type and plans of the measuring device(s) shall be approved by the Watermaster before beginning of construction work and the weir or measuring device shall be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 29, 1989, and together with Certificate 63764, supersedes Certificate 57358, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
