CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 2 in the WEST FORK SILVIES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATING 44.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permits G-4028, U-407, AND G-1530. The dates of priority are MARCH 15, 1968 - FOR 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; SEPTEMBER 10, 1951 - FOR 0.38 CFS; AND NOVEMBER 27, 1959 - FOR 0.09 CFS. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.55 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 25 S, R 30 E, W.M.; 1230 FEET SOUTH AND 510 FEET EAST FROM THE C 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of APPROPRIATION (WELL 2), shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original points of appropriation.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 25, 1991, and supersedes Certificates 44378, 44295, AND 36637 State Records of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
