CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

James P. Ingram Route 1 Box 124 Haines, OR 97833

confirms the right to use the waters of Rock Creek and Sand Creek, tributaries of Powder River for irrigation of 256.8 acres.

This right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The said decree is of record at Salem, in the Order record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, Volume 6, Page 291, Powder River Decree. The priority dates of the right hereby confirmed are 1890 for 117.2 acres, April 28, 1881 for 139.6 acres.

That the amount of water entitled and hereby confirmed for this right, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 6.42 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The points of diversion from the sources are located:

Div. Pt. 2 - Coles Ditch No. 2: 960 feet South and 1720 feet West from Northeast corner Section 31, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W.M.; Sand Creek

Div. Pt. 3 - Coles Ditch No. 1: 950 feet North and 500 feet West from center corner Section 36, Township 7 South, Range 38 East, W.M.; Rock Creek

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
