## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of Rock Creek and Sand Creek, a tributaries of Powder River for irrigation of 15.8 acres of land.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon and BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291, Powder River Decree. The dates of priority are 1890 for Tract 1 and April 28, 1881 for Tract 4.

The amount of water entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes a fore said is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed **ONE FORTIETH** of one cubic foot per second per acre **or** its equivalent in case of rotation.
