CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters from ONE HORIZONTAL INFILTRATION SYSTEM, WITHIN COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN, FOR FISHING REARING.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10870. The date of priority is JULY 15, 1988. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 27.3 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 16, T 5 N, R 26 E, W.M.; 3094.74 FEET NORTH AND 262.44 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
SECTION 15  
TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior SURFACE AND GROUNDWATER rights of others.

The well has been determined to be in hydraulic connection with the COLUMBIA RIVER and, if the need arises, the right will be regulated to reflect surface water use.

The user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
