CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WARREN J. FERGUSON  
1643 ANDERSON CREEK ROAD  
TALENT, OR 97540

confirms the right to use the waters of ANDERSON CREEK, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, for IRRIGATING 9.4 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1857.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.118 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion under the subject right.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 34, T 38 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 515 FEET NORTH AND 1030 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4	1.8 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	7.6 ACRES
SECTION 34	
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.	

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 21, 1988, and together with Certificate 60562, supersedes Certificate 52561, State Record of Water Right Certificates.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

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The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
