CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAYMOND S. AND JEAN N. BELNAP 4137 KOCHSMEIER ROAD VALE, OREGON 97918

confirms the right to use the waters of A SUMP in the WILLOW CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATING 3.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4851. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 17, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.046 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the SUMP.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 1, T 18 S, R 44 E, W.M.; 520 FEET SOUTH AND 1550 FEET EAST FROM N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 3.7 ACRES SECTION 1 TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST, W.M.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device of measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 11, 1990, and together with Certificate 64215, supersedes Certificate 41551, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
