CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DANIEL H. MEYER, SR. AND JACKIE M. MEYER 855 ELK CREEK ROAD TRAIL, OREGON 97541

confirms the right to use the waters of ELK CREEK, a tributary of THE ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATING 3.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1894.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.1 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion from the creek.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 33 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 2170 FEET NORTH AND 750 FEET EAST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 3.8 ACRES SECTION 30 TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 4, 1990, and together with Certificates 68169 AND 64428, supersedes Certificate 63764, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
