CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

AGNESS HEMSHORN

MT. ANGEL, OREGON 97362

confirms the right to use the waters of THE PUDDING RIVER, a tributary of THE MOLALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 20.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 13936. The date of priority is JULY 20, 1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.26 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 440 FEET NORTH AND 670 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 4.8 ACRES
SECTION 32

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 5.6 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 7.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 3.0 ACRES
SECTION 33

TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 26, 1990, and together with Certificate 65137, supersedes Certificate 16850, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
