## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DALY CREEK PASTORAL., CO P.O. BOX 29 GLENBROOK, NV 89413

confirms the right to use the waters of EAGLE CREEK AND DALY CREEK, a tributary of POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 264.0 acres of land.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is JULY 12, 1901.

The use is limited to 6.60 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

## HOWELL DITCH

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
