CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of EAGLE CREEK, tributary of POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 107.3 acres.

That said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, the Order record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, Page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates of 1878 for 52.3 acres, July 12, 1901 for 40.8 acres, 1885 for 7.2 acres, 1885 for 4.3 acres and 1872 for 2.7 acres.

That amount of water which such is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.68 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The points of diversion are located:

Gover Ditch - being within the NE1/4 NE1/4, Section 22, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W.M.; 1640 feet North and 290 feet West from East 1/4 corner of Section 22, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

Little Eagle Ditch - being within the SE1/4 SE1/4, Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W.M.; 250 feet North and 1020 feet West from the SE corner of Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

Kay Young Ditch - being within the SE1/4 NW1/4, Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W.M.; 1700 feet south and 2450 feet East from the NW corner of Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

Nash Ditch - being within the SW1/4 SE1/4, Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W.M.; 590 feet North and 2720 feet East from the SW corner of Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate confirms an order of the Director entered on APR 15 1996, 1996 and recorded in Special Order Volume 50, Page 200, approving a petition by Dan L. Forsea & Sons, Inc. Under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes a portions of certificates 4592, 4674, 4768, 52953, 52954.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
