CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

ELLIS N. PHILLIPS HC 83, BOX 294 COQUILLE, OREGON 97423

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of RINK CREEK, for IRRIGATING 0.5 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 50449. The date of priority is APRIL 21, 1988. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 28 S, R 12 W, W.M.; 1106 FEET SOUTH AND 905 FEET WEST FROM THE C-N 1/16 OF SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.5 ACRE SECTION 7 TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

This right is for beneficial use of water without waste.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
