CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the POWDER RIVER BASIN for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 8.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4548. The date of priority is MAY 1, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 20, T 9 S, R 40 E, W.M.; 1380 FEET NORTH AND 1970 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 5.0 ACRES SW 1/4 SE 1/4 3.0 ACRES SECTION 20 TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, W.M.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE TO PRIMARY IRRIGATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 28, 1991, and supersedes Certificate 37781, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
