## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HOWELL DITCH COMPANY RICHLAND, OREGON 97870

confirms the right to use SEEPAGE WATERS from WATERBURY-ALLEN DITCH, a tributary of POWDER RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 267.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 7227. The date of priority is MARCH 12, 1926. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

WITHIN the NE¼ NE¼ of SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
