confirms the right to use the waters of the TUALATIN RIVER, for the IRRIGATION OF 22.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 14610. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 7, 1940. The use is limited to 0.278 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 6 (NW¼SW¼), of SECTION 14, T2S, R2W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 21/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

16.4 ACRES LOT 6 (NW1/4SW1/4) 1.0 ACRES NW1/4SW1/4 AS PROJECTED WITHIN THE PHILIP SWANK DLC 48 4.6 ACRES LOT 7 (SW1/4SW1/4) 0.2 ACRES SW1/4SW1/4 AS PROJECTED WITHIN THE PHILIP SWANK DLC 48 SECTION 14 TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior Certificate 15735, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 25,1996

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610, pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.
