## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROCK CREEK MILLING COMPANY HAINES, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of ROCK CREEK, a tributary of POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 7.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1906.

The use is limited to 0.175 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or it's equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SCHOLL DITCH - SW1/4 NE1/4, Section 34, Township 7 South, Range 38 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

## SE¼ NE¼ 7.0 ACRES SECTION 34 TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 4435, State Record of Water Right Certificated, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources director entered on March 25, 1996 and recorded in Special Order Volume 50, Page 173.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to provisions of ORS 540.610, pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
