## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EVERETT ALAN AND LORRI L. MELTON 69172 BARCLAY COURT SISTERS, OR 97759

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the SQUAW CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 19.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11250. The date of priority is DECEMBER 17, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 3, T 15 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 1425 FEET SOUTH AND 238 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 14.2 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.3 ACRES
SECTION 3
TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.
```

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the department, the user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
