CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of THE TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATING 6.16 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 18533. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 1, 1948. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.077 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 1, T 2 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 720 FEET NORTH AND 1320 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-foot per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 6.16 ACRES
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 15, 1990, and together with Certificate 64734, supersedes Certificate 20084, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
