CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH POWDER RIVER, tributary of POWDER RIVER for STOCK and IRRIGATION of 107.1 acres.

This right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The said decree is of record at Salem, in the Order record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, Volume 3, Page 252. The priority dates of the right hereby confirmed are 1871 for stock and irrigation of 83.8 acres, 1882 for stock and irrigation of 23.3 acres.

That the amount of water entitled and hereby confirmed for this right, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.68 cubic feet per second, being 2.1 cfs of 1871 and 0.58 cfs of 1882, from March 1st to July 1st, and shall not exceed 1.34 cubic feet per second from July 1st to October 1st, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion from the source is located:

Hutchinson Hillside Ditch - NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T. 7 S., R. 38 E., W.M.: 140' S and 2380' W from the NE corner of Section 5.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water rights confirmed by certificate 1469 as modified by Transfer 3889, recorded at Special Order Volume 31 Page 138, State Record of Water Right Certificates, further modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 15, 1976 approving a petition by Richard Stevens Co-Petitioner with Powder Valley Water Control District under ORS 541.329.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
