CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

K. L. MEACHAM
RT. 1, BOX 725
VALE, OR 97918

confirms the right to use the waters of 2 WELLS in the MALHEUR RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 1.6 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 8.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8838. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.05 CFS FROM EACH WELL, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL 1: LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 27, T 18 S, R 45 E, W.M.; 480 FEET SOUTH AND 1340 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 27.

WELL 2: LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 27, T 18 S, R 45 E, W.M.; 440 FEET SOUTH AND 1460 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

PRIMARY

LOT 4 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4) 1.6 ACRES

SUPPLEMENTAL

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) 8.4 ACRES

SECTION 27

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
