CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PAUL R. AND ROSETTA A. KENT
ROUTE 2, BOX 1285
BANDON, OREGON 97411

confirms the right to store the waters of SIMPSON CREEK, a tributary of THE COQUILLE RIVER, in KENT RESERVOIR 1-A, appropriated under Permit 51140, for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-11342. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 13, 1988. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is NOT MORE THAN 4.15 ACRE-FEET.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 20
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resource Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
