CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to store the waters of KRUMBO CREEK, a tributary of DONNER UND BLITZEN RIVER, in KRUMBO RESERVOIR, appropriated under Permit 50750, for PUBLIC RECREATIONAL PURPOSES INCLUDING WILDLIFE ATTRACTION, FISHERY, BOATING AND SCENIC ATTRACTION.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-11162. The date of priority is JANUARY 26, 1989. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is 838.0 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located as follows:

The dam shall be operated and maintained in accordance to the approved plans and specifications on file with the Water Resource Department.

The water user shall comply with the terms and conditions of an order recorded in VOLUME 43, PAGES 403 THROUGH 407 and stipulated agreement recorded in VOLUME 43, PAGES 408 THROUGH 413, order records of the Water Resources Director.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
