CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN F. KUMLEY

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 24.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 20552. The date of priority is MAY 29, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.3 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 55, SECTION 28, T 6 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 610 FEET NORTH 36 DEGREES 41 MINUTES WEST FROM THE NW CORNER OF DLC 54.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 15.8 ACRES
SECTION 27

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 8.2 ACRES
SECTION 28

BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 55
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line, flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 27, 1990, and supersedes Certificate 24648, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
