CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CARL L. GILES 18352 TILLER TRAIL HIGHWAY DAYS CREEK, OREGON 97429

confirms the right to use the waters of THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of THE UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 18.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 4213. The date of priority is AUGUST 19, 1919. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.23 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 37, SECTION 29, T 30 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 120 FEET NORTH AND 1170 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When required by the department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the amount of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND CORRECTION IN THE PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 30, 1991, and supersedes Certificate 3736, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
