CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED CREEK, a tributary of THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 34621. The date of priority is AUGUST 25, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 20, T 30 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1010 FEET NORTH AND 540 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 20.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 30, 1991, and supersedes Certificate 41427, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
