CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

F. W. LEVERENZ  
Tumalo, Oregon

confirms the right to use the waters of Squaw Creek, a tributary of Deschutes River, for irrigation of 42.8 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 471. The date of priority is the year 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.856 cubic foot per second. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4            28.8 acres  
SW 1/4 NW 1/4            12.0 acres

NE 1/4 SE 1/4            2.0 acres

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 857, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 24, 1996.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
