CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

NORTH UMPQUA BIBLE FELLOWSHIP
1547 WILD RIVER DRIVE
ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of THE NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of THE UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 2.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 25203. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 26, 1957. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40, SECTION 14, T 26 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 2170 FEET NORTH AND 3160 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.4 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 14, 1990, and together with Certificate 64097, supersedes Certificate 29351, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

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The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
