## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD E. AND MARTHA J. BISHOP 70397 BUCKHORN ROAD TERREBONNE, OREGON 97760

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATING 109.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permits G-7360, WITH A DATE OF PRIORITY OF DECEMBER 15, 1976; AND G-10677, WITH A DATE OF PRIORITY OF JULY 11, 1986. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.369 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 0.799 CFS EVIDENCED BY PERMIT G-7360; AND 0.57 CFS EVIDENCED BY PERMIT G-10677, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL NO. 8 - SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 20, T 14 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 2329 FEET SOUTH AND 1047 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 20.

WELL NO. 10 - NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 20, T 14 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 52 FEET SOUTH AND 1260 FEET EAST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Well No. 10), shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation (Well No. 8).

When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

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The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This certificate is issued to confirm AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION (WELL NO. 10) approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 28, 1991, and together with Certificate 65151, supersedes Certificates 53613 AND 64142, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
