## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHRIS WALTER WRIGHT AND CAROL WYCKOFF 2132 NE KLAMATH AVENUE ROSEBURG, OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAR CREEK, a tributary of HUBBARD CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 0.7 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 16730. The date of priority is DECEMBER 26, 1945. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.009 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 1, T 26 S, R 8 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.7 ACRE SECTION 1 TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECT THE ERROR BY SPECIAL ORDER VOLUME 41, PAGE 159 OF THE WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
