## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JACK E. AND SUSAN E. SHEKELL P.O. BOX 43 VIDA, OR 97488

confirms the right to use the waters of MCKENZIE RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 6.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 26475. The date of priority is DECEMBER 9, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

ORIGINAL POD: SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 16 S, R 2 E, W.M.

ADDITIONAL POD: LOT 1 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 28, T 16 S, R 2 E, W.M.; 231 FEET NORTH AND 849 FEET WEST FROM THE WEST MEANDER CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 27 AND 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 1 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4) 6.2 ACRES SECTION 28 TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 2 EAST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 3, 1992, and together with Certificate 67250, supersedes Certificate 51989, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
