confirms the right to use the waters of the Pudding River, a tributary of the Molalla River, for the irrigation of 20.4 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 14630. The date of priority is September 25, 1940. The use is limited to 0.255 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 29, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, WM

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 11.9 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 8.5 acres Both as projected within DLC 42 Section 29 Township 6 South, Range 1 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior Certificate 33901, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 19, 1996.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610, pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
