CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HARRY G. SPENCER P.O. BOX 291 LANGLOIS, OREGON 97450

confirms the right to use the waters of CONNER CREEK AND SPENCER RESERVOIR, tributaries of DAVIS CREEK, for IRRIGATION AND TEMPERATURE CONTROL OF 7.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50948. The date of priority is APRIL 26, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.3 CFS FOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL OR 0.09 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 11, T 30 S, R 15 W, W.M.; 780 FEET NORTH AND 50 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 7.3 ACRES
SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 15 WEST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
