CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN AND MABEL HOCKEMA
3202 HIGHWAY 34
WALDPORT, OREGON 97394

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of ALSEA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 50832. The date of priority is JUNE 14, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 13 S, R 11 W, W.M.; 240 FEET NORTH AND 650 FEET EAST FROM THE CS 1/16 CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


NW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
