## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of THE ALSEA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED FOR TWO FAMILIES.

This right was perfected under Permit 51301. The date of priority is APRIL 3, 1991. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 13 S, R 10 W, W.M.; 260 FEET NORTH AND 560 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
