CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAGER FARMS, INC. AND RAYMOND JAGER 28645 JAGER LANE JUNCTION CITY, OREGON 97448

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO. 1 in the FLAT CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 16.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6499. The date of priority is JUNE 18, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 55, SECTION 18, T 5 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 4.74 FEET SOUTH AND 1571.23 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF DLC 54.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 9.4 ACRES SW 1/4 SE 1/4 6.6 ACRES BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 55 SECTION 18 TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Well No. 1) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation (Well No. 2).

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning Construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 18, 1991, and supersedes Certificate 52067, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
