CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the SILVER CREEK BASIN for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 16.8 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 8.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-385. The date of priority is APRIL 10, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

LOT 3 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 2, T 27 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 1342 FEET SOUTH AND 2646 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 12, 1989, and supersedes Certificate 31369, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
