CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DARRELL AND LUELLA FRIEND

confirms the right to use the waters of TROUT CREEK, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATING 114.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 40187. The date of priority is JANUARY 13, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 2.87 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 24, NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 25, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 36, T 9 S, R 16 E, W.M.; DIVERSION NO. 1 - 200 FEET SOUTH AND 600 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 24; DIVERSION NO. 2 - 350 FEET SOUTH AND 80 FEET EAST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25; DIVERSION NO. 3 - 1000 FEET NORTH AND 300 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
